## Who we are

*Richmond Community Services Incorporated (RCSI) works together with local residents and the community to identify needs and improve services to the Hawkesbury.*

**Community Development and Support** – RCSI’s ongoing commitment to the community is well represented with ongoing FREE workshops addressing issues such as Anger Management for Parents, Dealing with Sibling Rivalry, Anti Bullying Strategies, Timeout for Mum’s, Helping Kid’s Deal with responses to loss, RAGE – Anger Management for Boys, Stress Less for Men. All are these initiatives are developed in direct response to gaps in services and feedback from our clients and local interagencies.

**Family Support** - This service supports families under stress or in crisis with dependent children who are living in Richmond/Windsor and surrounding suburbs. Home visits or Centre-based sessions provide information and referral, counselling and support to families. The service also provides a “TIME OUT” group for isolated parents caring for children aged 0 –8 years needing some time with other parents to learn new skills and have fun together

**Neighbour Aid** - Neighbour Aid is a social home visiting service for frail aged people, people with a disability and their carers. Volunteers are recruited from the community and visit clients two hours a week on a one to one basis, with the aim to assist clients to remain living independently in their homes to delay inappropriate or premature residential care.

The core aim of the Neighbour Aid project is to relieve social isolation and to support the person to participate within his or her own community. This can be either within the person’s home environment or while the person is accessing community services or facilities.

**Community Centre Activities** - by providing a wealth of our own work and space for other community services activities we ensure that the centre is always busy, open to all in the community and at the heart of the local community.
